

ORATORY CORNER
St John Henry Newman wrote two novels: Loss and Gain and Callista. Loss and Gain is set in 1830s at Oxford University. The main character Charles is being asked to accept the 39 Articles of the Anglican church if he wants to be ordained. *Callista* is a love story set in the 3rd century. Can Callista, in the midst of persecution, come to believe what the Catholic she loves believes? Can Charles believe without a proof?

These two novels reflect the two parts of Newman's 1870 masterpiece, An Essay in Aid of a Grammar of Assent. Known by its shorter title, Grammar of Assent, this book is thought to be Newman's most difficult work, most intimidating work. The "object of the book [is] twofold", Newman once told Edward Caswall: "In the first part shows that you can believe what you do not understand. In the second part that you can believe what you cannot absolutely prove."

As we went Advent, let us pray for faith that God exists. Let us pray to believe what we cannot fully understand. Let us pray to believe what we cannot absolutely prove. Newman did. We can too.
