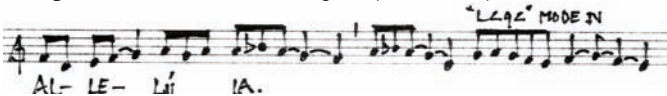

PURPLE VESTMENTS AT LATIN MASS?

Starting this Sunday, the Church's Latin liturgy enters her traditional pre-Lenten season: Septuagesima. For three weeks leading up to Ash Wednesday (February 18), the Church traditionally wears purple vestments to remind us of the upcoming 40 Days of Penance. *What will we give up this Lent? What spiritual practices will be do? What almsgiving is needed?* Starting this Sunday, the Church in many places reads from the book of Genesis. These early chapters of Genesis show us the grace of this season. Septuagesima season carries special graces to help us know that we are created by God, but also alienated from God by original sin. Septuagesima literally means 70. From this Sunday to Easter, there are 63 days. The Church rounds up!

ORATORY CORNER

Newman in a Nutshell 8.0 – St John Henry, 2nd Founder of the Oratory, Cardinal, newest doctor of the Church, pray for us and teach us.

We have been examining Newman's teaching about **original sin**. We have seen his argument for the fact of original sin from the existence of God and the experience of the human condition. *But what is the original sin?* Newman writes: "When man cast off God, his passions and affections rebelled against his reason, and his body against his soul" (Sermon Notes, 'State of Original Sin,' 3 March 1861). Original sin can mean two things:

1. *When man cast off God = the original sin*
2. *Affections rebelling against reason = state of original sin*

Original sin is the first sin, recounted in Genesis 3 in which our first parents actually disobeyed God. Original sin can also mean the state of deprivation "of the supernatural unmerited grace which Adam and Eve had on their first formation, -- deprivations and the consequences of deprivation (Letter to Pusey, 1865). This state of being deprived of God's grace and its consequences of our affection rebelling against reason and our bodies against our souls is also called original sin. We are born in this state of original sin, a state remedied by baptism. Do we know our baptismal date?
