
STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND BENEDICTION

If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me.

Meditating on our Lord's Passion by doing the Stations of the Cross is an excellent way of learning His love and mercy for us. Have you considered making a visit to the Blessed Sacrament and praying the Stations of the Cross on your own during this Lenten season?



St Philip Neri, whose image is in our church, was known to have imperturbable patience. He was known to always have a smiling face, yet mixed with gravity. He was known to welcome all who came to him with kindness. But there was one thing that would make him upset. When he found the church's atmosphere of prayer being hindered. He did not like beggars inside the church asking for money. He did not like workmen making more noise than necessary. He would drive beggars outside. He would ask the workman if they had to be so loud.

DISCOVERING CHRIST

Are you interested in diving into fundamental questions like, "What's my purpose?" and "Why does Jesus matter?" All people, whether Catholic or non-Catholic, in the pews or never baptized, ask these questions. Discovering Christ is a seven week journey to find answers, or rather, to find the Answer to the purpose of life. Join us for a community dinner, teaching, small group discussion, and prayer. The heart of Discovering Christ is this: the Good News is for YOU! It's life-changing. Encounter God's love in a relational setting. Our parish is the first parish in Toronto to host this exciting program. Discovering Christ is about conversion. Meetings begin Thursday, April 9.

Life of St John Henry Newman (2nd Founder)

Lent is about **conversion**. We *fast* to help ourselves. We *pray* to help our relationship with God. We *give alms* to help our relationship with others. Conversion to three-fold: self, God, and others. Conversion is about turning, turning towards God, towards our own true happiness, and towards helping others reach God.



Newman's deep conversion happened when he was 15. He became convinced that God was real. He knew God dwelt in his heart. One of the first things he did was to study the **Athanasian Creed**. He fell in love with that ancient prayer, that "war-song of faith," as he would later call it in the *Grammar of Assent*. Newman realized that the Holy Trinity was the fundamental truth of the Christian faith. With the help of a few books, Newman "*made a collection of Scripture texts in proof of the doctrine, with remarks (I think) of my own upon them, before I was sixteen; and a few months later I drew up a series of texts in support of each verse of the Athanasian Creed. These papers I have still*" (*Apologia*).
