MISSIONARIES VISITED SVP

In 1951, the first Missionary Sisters of the Precious Blood arrived in Toronto, Ontario at the invitation of the late Cardinal James McGuigan. In 1954, the Sisters opened St. Bernard's Convalescent Hospital. They continue to run St Bernard's as a nursing home.

Last Saturday, in honour of their 75th anniversary in Toronto, the sisters came to Mass at St Vincent de Paul. Why? Because in 1951, their first house was at 221 Indian Road. These sisters from South Africa were very, very poor. They said that our parish' generosity is what kept them alive!

Our parish has long been a place that fostered female religious vocations. On this Pentecost Sunday, let us remember that many women were gathered in the Upper Room when the Holy Spirit descended. Let us pray for God to still up a desire in the hearts of many women to give themselves totally to Christ.

He was God's instrument to refocus the Church upon the simplicity of the Gospel message. The drama of his life and message has inspired the imagination of artists, poets, and filmmakers, and the admiration of innumerable people, both inside and outside the Church. He lives on most especially in those men and women who have chosen to follow his way of poverty and service. The Church has been enriched by his poverty. The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person.
