ORATORY SUMMER SCHOOL

Registration for the annual Oratory Summer School has opened. There are two sessions available, each with 3 lectures per day.

NEWMAN CORNER

In 1741, St Marguerite d'Youville faced an agonizing situation. She was a widow and a mother of two sons. Her husband had left her in humiliating circumstances because of his criminality and debts. God had led her to take care of the most abandoned in the young city of Montreal. Her spiritual director and the inspiration of her Grey Nuns was dying. St Marguerite promised God the Father that she would have a image of him painted if her spiritual director and confessor got better. He did. And she got this painting made in France in 1741.



How are we to think of God the Father? We must start by thinking of His Son. *No one knows the Father, Jesus said, except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him (Mt 11:27)*. Our Lord had shown us that in God there is an eternal Father. God is not just the Father of his creation; He is Father to an eternal Son. On this Father's Day weekend, let us ponder this truth. Let us turn to the latest doctor of the Church for light on why God's Fatherhood matters.

In one of his Meditations and Devotions, St John Henry Newman writes: *What mind of man can imagine the love which the Eternal Father bears towards the Only Begotten Son? It has been from everlasting,—and it is infinite; so great is it that divines call the Holy Ghost by the name of that love, as if to express its infinitude and perfection. Yet reflect, O my soul, and bow down before the awful mystery, that, as the Father loves the Son, so doth the Son love thee, if thou art one of His elect; for He says expressly, "As the Father hath loved Me, I also have loved you. Abide in My love." What mystery in the whole circle of revealed truths is greater than this?*

Let us concentrate ourselves in the love Christ has for us. As the Father loves the Son, as He gives him everything He has, so the Son gives us all He has.
